



Mpiirwe went missing on Friday

Police hunt shamba boy over missing child

The Kira Road Divisional Police are investigating an alleged kidnapping of a six-year-old boy on Friday.

Kampala Metropolitan Police spokesperson Racheal Kawala identified the missing boy as Abraham Mpiirwe Tumwesigye.

The boy was allegedly kidnapped by David Muchunguzi, who was working as a shamba boy at the home of the victim in Ddungu zone, Kisaasi, Kawempe division.

"It is alleged that on Friday, at around 4:00pm, Muchunguzi, who was employed as a shamba boy by Dr Emmanuel Tumwesigye, left with the victim (Mpiirwe), a son of Dr Tumwesigye, to an unknown destination and did not return," Kawala said.

She said a kidnapping case was reported at Universal Police Post, and relevant statements were recorded. Kawala added that efforts to arrest the suspect were ongoing.

She urged the public to share any information regarding the whereabouts of the suspect or the victim with the Police to aid investigations and the safe recovery of the child.
