

LOST CHILDREN

ERINAH DUMPED IN SALON

About a week after birth, Erinah was abandoned by her unknown mother at a salon in January 2025. The woman posed as a customer and, upon arrival, asked to use the toilet before having her hair done. She placed the baby on a salon chair and went behind the building where the toilets were located.

Because the salon owner and her two employees were busy attending to other customers, it took them about an hour to realise the woman had disappeared.

The matter was reported to Kawala Police and recorded under S/D Ref: 20/22/01/2025. The baby was later referred to Sanyu Babies' Home for temporary care and protection as investigations continue.

Solomon abandoned at Old Taxi Park

Apio, who works at the Old Taxi Park, said one day, a woman walked up to her and asked her to help her keep her baby as she went to the nearby toilet for a short call. The woman never returned.

Apio recalls keeping the baby from about 2:30pm to 4:30pm. The case was reported to Central Police Station Kampala under SD Ref: 75/7/10/24. The baby was later referred to Sanyu Babies' Home for temporary care and protection as investigations continue.

BABY LEFT AT HOSPITAL

Records show that a woman identified as Irene Nandutu gave birth to a baby girl on August 25, 2024 at Orthodox Hospital, Namungoona in Kampala. She had arrived alone. Two days later, she vanished from the hospital, abandoning her newborn baby.

The case was reported to Namungoona Police Post under Ref: 06/28/08/2024 and later forwarded to Old Kampala Child and Family Protection Unit under CFDR 165/2024. The baby was referred to Sanyu Babies' Home as investigations continued.

FATHER ABANDONS OWN CHILDREN

A man only identified as Isaac, a resident of Kigwanya zone in Busega parish, routinely left his two children, Elijah and Adrian, with a neighbourhood caregiver for several years. He would drop them off in the morning as he went to work and pick them up in the evening.

In October 2023, Isaac left the children as usual, but never returned. No one knew the whereabouts of their mother or any other close relatives.

A Good Samaritan in the neighbourhood, Daisy Nankinga, took temporary

responsibility for the children. She reported the matter to the chairman of Kigwanya zone, who referred her to Nateete Police Station.

The case was registered under SD Ref: 80/09/10/2023, and the children were referred to Sanyu Babies' Home.

Later, some paternal relatives were traced in Mutundwe-Kirinyabigo. However, they suggested that the siblings be given up for adoption.

Schoolgirl deserts baby boy at medical centre

On October 25, 2024, a young woman identified as Mazahib Ahmed arrived at Muhsian Medical Centre in Bulange A, Lubaga Division, Kampala. She presented a letter indicating she had given birth to a baby boy at Kawempe Hospital.

She pleaded with management to keep the baby, explaining that she was still in school and unable to care for him. As staff explained that this was not possible, she tactfully escaped, leaving the baby behind.

The case was reported to Old Kampala Police Station under SD Ref: 26/27/10/2024. The baby was later referred to Sanyu Babies' Home for temporary care and protection as investigations continue.
