

# MOCK PLE WAKE-UP CALL SPURS OKELLO TO AGGREGATE 4 IN FINALS

Andrew Joseph Okello Okiror emerged among the three best candidates at Naggalama Junior School in Nakifuma-Naggalama town council after scoring aggregate 4 in the 2025 Primary Leaving Examinations (PLE).

Okello said his outstanding performance was sparked by a disappointing aggregate 7 in the mock exams, despite his earlier hard work.

He described the result as a wake-up call that pushed him to read harder and refocus on his goal of scoring aggregate 4 in PLE.

The son of Capt. Ben Okiror and Jacenta Asima of Namanve in Mukono municipality, Okello said he had become overconfident. However, the setback in the mocks helped him regain discipline and determination.

"I had promised my parents that I would score aggregate 4 in PLE to fulfil my dream of becoming an architect. I could

not imagine going off the track again. I thank God that through hard work I managed to accomplish my dream," Okello said.

Capt. Okiror told *New Vision* that Okello has broken the family record, saying the

best performer among his siblings previously had scored aggregate 6. Okello now aspires to join Namilyango College.

Another top performer of the school, Jonathan Mugerwa, the son of Prossy Kayodi and

Sam Kato of Nakanyonyi in Nakifuma-Naggalama town council, also got aggregate 4. He hopes to become an engineer and plans to join Mt. St Henry's High School Mukono.

Other strong performers of the school include David Junior Opio, Joram Lutakome, Joash Mayanja and Janet Naganda, who each scored aggregate 5.

Their headteacher, Ronald Lujaganya, said the school presented 52 candidates and registered a 100% first-grade pass rate, with three candidates attaining aggregate 4.
