

Huawei, Vision Group explore deeper partnership on digital, media innovation

Huawei Uganda and Vision Group have held a high-level engagement to explore deeper collaboration in digital infrastructure, media technology and skills development.

Vision Group's CEO, Don Wanyama, outlined the company's evolution into Uganda's largest multimedia organisation, with operations spanning print, radio, television, digital platforms, commercial printing, logistics, events and advertising. The group reaches millions of Ugandans daily and is increasingly investing in digital products, data-driven content and technology-enabled services.

Huawei highlighted its footprint in Uganda and the wider sub-Saharan Africa region, citing its role in building telecom networks from 2G to 5G, supporting the National Backbone Infrastructure and partnering with the Government on key e-services.

The engagement also covered Huawei's media-sector solutions, including networks, cloud, data centres, cybersecurity and intelligent collaboration tools, alongside its digital skills and community programmes.

The discussions laid the groundwork for a strategic partnership to support innovation and Uganda's digital transformation.
