The facility has the highest number of production for babies. It is very critical to have oxygen so that every mother can walk back home with a baby.

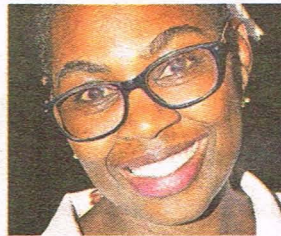


Joan Kantu Elsie, Rotarian

Officer-in-charge of ante natal ward.** Every Thursday, we attend to adolescent pregnant girls, we have to screen them for HIV, Hepatitis and Syphilis for them to know their status. Those who are positive, we enrol them on treatment immediately.

Asst I/C Ante Natal clinic.** Today, we have received about 12 mothers who do not know the men responsible for their pregnancies. They actually come to abort, but through counselling, they accept to take on the pregnancy.
